The health facilities offer a range of services as per the required standards according to the level of the service care point and all these services offered are completely free of charge.

Kazo Health Center IV serves as the District Referral Centre with fully functional Theatre, Oxygen therapy, liver functional and renal functional testing and blood transfusion services. On average, the Theatre operates 27 Mothers every month.

The blood transfusion services started in 2019 with 21 units but we have observed an increase in demand as shown in the table below

District Health Service Delivery Report

The district boasts of eight accredited sites for ART (i.e Kazo H/C IV, Rwemikoma H/C III, Burunga H/C III, Nkungu H/C III, Buremba H/C III, Kanoni H/C III, Lamezia H/C III and Engari community.

Viral load testing for all patients in the district is exclusively done at Kazo HC IV, and the facility also serves as a point of care site.

In addition to other laboratory services, we also offer liver tests and renal functional tests.
